

Indaba Bush Camp



Philosophy

'Indaba' (Zulu for '**meeting place, coming together**') is a bush camp located in the northern section of our zoo. It is a place to **BE** and is deliberately spartan. Indaba has been developed to encourage individuals to become one with the natural environment. It promotes a sense of community. While basic facilities are provided, the simple nature of the camp challenges all to be flexible and adaptive.

Location

The bush camp precinct is a non-public area approximately 3km drive from the Visitors Centre. Your group will have access to the bush camp from 4pm until midday on Day2 (unless otherwise negotiated with a Zoo Educator). No Bus or private car may head to the campsite without authorization.

Facilities

SHEARING SHED

Kept in original condition, the shearing shed is 'semi enclosed' but is rain and wind proof. Students can lay their mattresses and swags out on the raised wooden floor. No electricity - lanterns provided.



THE HUB

A 3-sided paved shed (the fourth side being shade blinds) with electricity, mains water and fans. This is the main meeting area for eating, activities and food preparation. The Hub contains the following:

- Fridge and Freezer
- Trestle tables and benches
- Kitchen area
- Crockery, utensils and equipment needed to prepare, eat and clean
- Whiteboard
- Beanbags for chilling out
- Paved Verandah area
- Gas and wood fire patio heaters
