Junior Wildlife Days

Have a wild time at the Zoo!

Wondering what theme to teach this term? Why don't you let the Adelaide Zoo Education Service help you and book a Junior Wildlife Day! For a \$25 fee (plus zoo entry) we can provide you with the following:

- 🐾 a full day itinerary for your visit to the Zoo

- 🐾 a 45 minute lesson with an Education Officer

You can choose from one of the following topics:

Habitats: What is a habitat? Look at features of different habitats and find out which animals you would find in them. Find out how these animals have adapted to their environment.

Camouflage: Look at the way animals have adapted to hide in their natural environments. Try and find some of our best camouflages in the Zoo.

Australian Animals: Australia has some of the most unique animals in the world. Find out about marsupials and monotremes and see what you can do to help our environment.

Predators: What is a predator? Why are they so important in natural food chains? Find out how predators catch their prey and which ones we have at the Adelaide Zoo.

Rainforests: Discover how the world's tiny rainforests hold over ½ of the Earth's entire plant and animal species. What is a rainforest? What animals would you see in them?

Reduce, Reuse and Recycle: What can you do to help the environment? Find out how we can reduce the waste in our homes and school and make a difference in this world.

Threatened Species: What is a threatened species? How have they become threatened and what can we do to help them? Search for the most threatened animals at the Zoo.

Wonderful Water: Which animals rely on water for survival? Find out the importance of water and ways that we can help to keep it clean. Find the best swimmers and divers at the Zoo.

Reptiles: What is a reptile and what makes them different to other animals? Find out about some of the reptiles at the Zoo and touch a turtle shell, snake and crocodile skin.

Deserts: How do animals survive in such dry, barren conditions? Find out about the amazing adaptations desert animals have.

Climate Change: Global Warming, Greenhouse Gases – what does it all mean? How does it affect us and our environment? Find out things we can all do to help.
