Conditions of Entry

- 1.** There is only one entry category – open. Entries will be judged on merit with the following considerations:
 - Age
 - Originality
 - Effort
 - Popularity (there will be a free voting system)
- 2.** Entries will be hosted on TeacherTube, YouTube, Adam Internet and any other site as determined by Conservation Ark.
- 3.** Popularity voting will be via the Conservation Ark website voting system only (i.e. not YouTube or TeacherTube popularity).
- 4.** Prizes.
First prize (donated by AV Central):

- 5.** All short listed entrants will be invited to a presentation event at Adelaide Zoo, where the winners will be announced.
- 6.** Contest organisers reserve the right to republish the videos on a DVD.
- 7.** Winners will be announced in July 2010 and the results will be available on the Conservation Ark website.
- 8.** Entrants must be South Australian school students – teachers may assist.
- 9.** Each video must be an original work and must not have been previously published. It must also not have been accepted for publication or under offer to any publisher or entered in another contest until the results of ZooTube school video competition are announced.
- 10.** Entries must be submitted to Conservation Ark via post, on a disk or flash drive (these will not be returned) in any of the following formats:
 - AVI
 - Quicktime
 - MPEG4
 - WMVDo not upload your video to TeacherTube or YouTube. We will do that for you.

Submissions will not be returned, so authors should retain a copy. Please do not send your entries via email. They will not be accepted.

Please enclose a stamped addressed envelope if you want to be notified that we have received your entry. Alternatively, you can supply an email address. Please be aware that sometimes free email addresses (hotmail, yahoo, etc.) malfunction.
- 11.** Please include relevant credits on your video.
- 12.** Each entry must be accompanied by a separate entry form listing the video title, along with the name, address and contact details of the responsible adult.
- 13.** Conservation Ark accepts no liability for loss or damage of videos.
- 14.** Conservation Ark reserves the right to use the videos after the competition is completed.
- 15.** The judges' decision is final and no correspondence about the prizes will be entered in to.
- 16.** The judges reserve the right not to award the prize.
- 17.** Deadline: entries must be postmarked no later than Friday 25 June 2010.
- 18.** All responsibility for copyright clearance, parent/guardian permissions and content must be taken by the school prior to submitting your entry.
