Junior Wildlife Days

Have a wild time at the Zoo!

Wondering what theme to teach this term? Why don't you let the Adelaide Zoo Education Service help you and book a Junior Wildlife Day! For a \$30 fee (plus zoo entry) we can provide you with the following:

-  **a full day itinerary for your visit to the Zoo**
-  **a 45 minute lesson with an Education Officer**

You can choose from one of the following topics:

Habitats: What is a habitat? Look at features of different habitats and find out which animals you would find in them. Discover the importance of animal habitats in the wild and at the Zoo. Find out how these animals have adapted to their environment.

Australian Animals: Australia has some of the most unique animals in the world. Find out about marsupials and monotremes and see what you can do to help our environment.

Rainforests: Discover how the world's tiny rainforests hold over ½ of the Earth's entire plant and animal species. What is a rainforest? What animals would you see in them?

Threatened Species: One of Adelaide Zoo's major roles is to save animals from extinction. Explore the key threatening processes facing animal species around the world. Learn about the meaning of endangered, threatened and vulnerable.

Animals Up-Close : Students learn about animals survival needs in relation to one another and their environment . As well discover concepts about animal growth and development through meeting a live zoo animal in the classroom.
