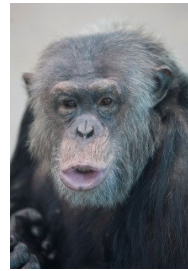

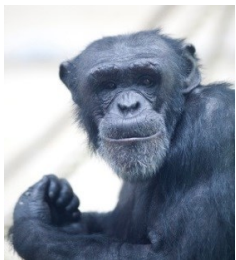

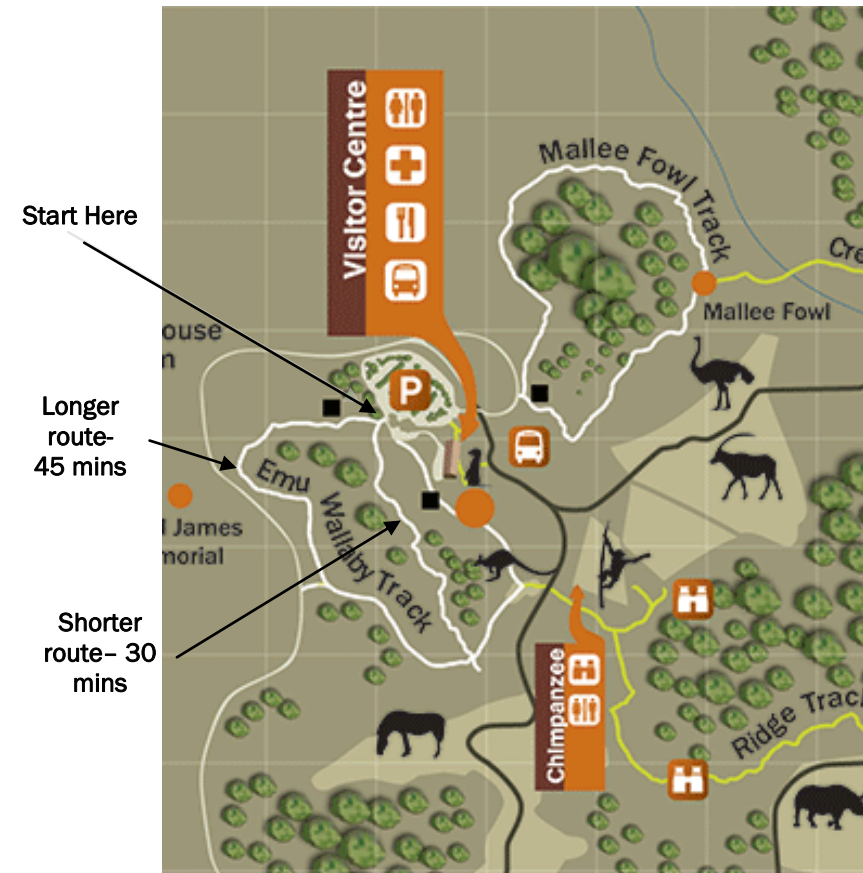

Challenge #1

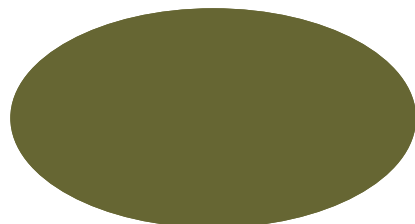
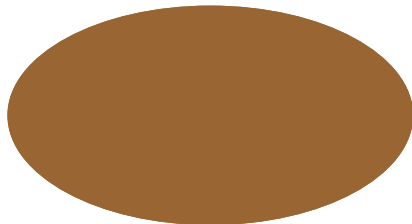
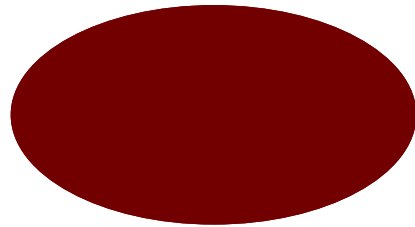
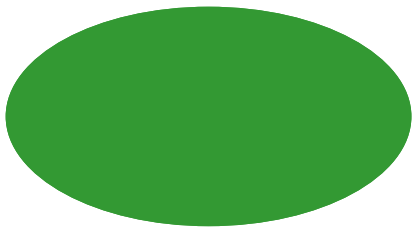
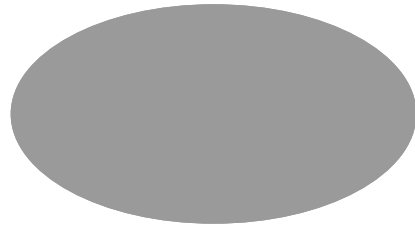
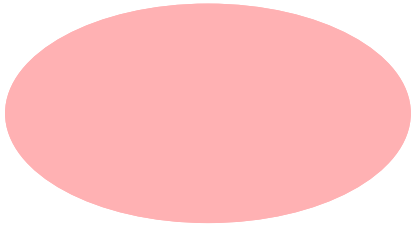
Stop two hundred meters along the track. Look for signs that animals live here:
